Apocalyptic - forecasting the ultimate destiny of the world: prophetic¹

Writer: The Book of Revelation was written by John the Apostle (1:1, 1:4, 1:9, 21:2 KJV; 22:8).

Date: The Book of Revelation was probably written between A.D. 95 and 96, during the reign of Domitian (A.D. 81-96).

Literary Format: The Book of Revelation is a general epistle.

- The Book of Revelation is Johannine:
 - The Gospel of John
 - First John
 - Second John
 - Third John
 - Revelation
- The Book of Revelation is an apocalyptic book.

Purpose: The Book of Revelation was a circular letter to read among the Seven Churches of Asia Minor (22:16). Furthermore, the Book of Revelation is a message of hope particularly adapted to those who are passing through, or who know they may soon be called to pass through, fierce temptation.²
